Wednesday 11 January - Sunday 15 January 2017 - Melbourne City Council

Passerby (male) - *"Great idea, you could add images."*

Passerby (male) - Guitar players talks about Halley's Comet.

Passerby (female) - *"What is it?"*

Passerby (male) - *"Can I get a ride on that?"*

Passersby (male & female) - *"What it is about, what it is for?"*

Passersby (male) - As two men walk past they try to finish sentence being displayed. The sentence starts with the word 'Return' and they say, *"... of the Jedi."* However, the end of the actual sentence is 'of Halley's Comet'.

Passerby (male) - *"If you added a logo you could get sponsorship."*

Passerby (male) - *"What are you selling?"*

Passerby (male) - *"Who is behind it?"*

Oush (male) - He stops to talk looking at the numbers on the PPFV as it is being wheeled along the street. He says that he likes numbers and explains his favourite numbers. He talks about symbols in architecture in Melbourne and how these reference ancient symbols from Africa. He talks about the Periodic table, the importance of science and maths as building blocks and about energy. He says that he dreamed last night that he was going to meet a girl and have this conversation. Asking for a significant year, he says, *"the year elements were found, as this was when technology advanced very fast."*
